ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 25, 2023, Federal Trade Commission Complaint Counsel filed a second motion to extend the time for it to respond to the motion of Calyx Technology, Inc. ("Calyx"), filed April 6, 2023, to quash or limit a subpoena for documents served on Calyx by Complaint Counsel on March 27, 2023 ("Motion to Extend"). Complaint Counsel states that Complaint Counsel and Calyx are engaged in productive, ongoing negotiations regarding the scope and timing of Calyx's document production in response to the subpoena and that an extension of time until May 5, 2023 may facilitate the narrowing or elimination of issues requiring resolution by the Court. Complaint Counsel further states that it has conferred with counsel for Calyx and that Calyx's counsel does not oppose the extension requested in the motion.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion to Extend is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that Complaint Counsel's deadline to respond to Calyx's motion to quash or limit Complaint Counsel's subpoena is extended to May 5, 2023.
