Re: Unsubstantiated claims for Coronavirus prevention or treatment

To Whom It May Concern:

This is to advise you that FTC staff reviewed your website at https://www.copperh2o.com/ in September 2020. We have also reviewed your social media websites at https://www.facebook.com/copperh2o, https://www.instagram.com/copperh2o/, and https://www.pinterest.com/copperh2o/, and your YouTube channel at https://www.youtube.com/channel/UC59RUeKbIOjAcKY4t21qIoQ, where you direct consumers to your website, https://www.copperh2o.com/, to purchase copper water bottles and other products. We have determined that you are unlawfully advertising that certain products treat or prevent Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19).

Examples of Coronavirus prevention or cure claims on your website include:

• "Copper and Coronavirus: Complete Guide (Updated Sept. 2020)... [page includes an image of a man blowing his nose amidst an image of huge coronavirus floating in the air]

Research has shown that copper has anti-bacterial and anti-viral properties which make it a potential tool in the fight against the coronavirus (COVID-19)....

Research and Studies Specific to the Coronavirus

...The first notable study... focused on coronavirus 229E (HuCoV-229E)... found that the virus persisted in an infectious state on common surface materials for several days. However, when the surface material contained copper, the scientists observed rapid inaction of the coronarvirus [sic]... metal alloys containing 90% copper were

found to inactivate the virus in 30 minutes or less.... The researchers concluded that copper surfaces could... help reduce transmission of respiratory viruses from contaminated surfaces and protect the public health....

In another study, it was determined that copper can help prevent respiratory viruses, such as the coronavirus, from spreading. In that study, scientists found that the coronavirus was rapidly inactivated within a few minutes by copper surfaces.
